**Weekly Children’s Programs begin September 7<sup>th</sup> at 10am**

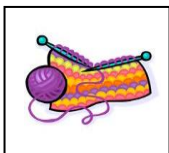
**TUESDAYS – ZOOM in Baby story time** -25 minutes of story & song

**WEDNESDAYS – Music in Motion for Toddlers**

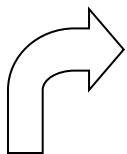
A fun half hour of music and songs for ages 1-4 years old.
