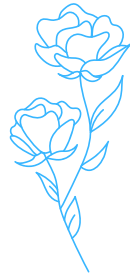
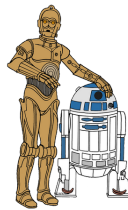

Come take your troubles and worries away with us and make your own worry doll!

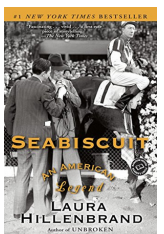


ALL THINGS CULINARY THURSDAY, MAY 19TH @ 6:00PM
