Daytrips:

Monmouth Battlefield (Manalapan Township, New Jersey) [Free]

- Take photo on left flank of Perrine Hill, where the 1st Connecticut Regiment and Franklin soldiers faced down the British.
- Take photo at Sutfin Farmhouse, where the 4th and 8th Connecticut Regiments, including Franklin soldiers, were ordered at one point on the morning of the battle.

Saratoga (Stillwater, New York) [Free]

• Take a photo at the site of Freeman's Farm, Barber Wheatfield, or the "Bloody Knoll" where Franklin soldiers fought.

Valley Forge (King of Prussia, Pennsylvania) [Free]

• Take a photo at the sites where Varnum's Brigade or Huntington's Brigade encamped, Franklin soldiers were among their numbers!

Battle Road Trail (Lexington & Concord, Massachusetts) [Free]

• Take a photo anywhere at Battle Road Trail with a landmark visible.

Connecticut:

Benedict Arnold Walking Trail (Norwich) [Free]

Take a photo at any of the trail signs.

Fort Griswold Battlefield (Groton) [Free]

• Take a photo inside the fort

CT River Museum (Essex) [Borrow museum pass from Library for free entry]

• Take a photo with the sign for the *Oliver Cromwell* or inside the model of the *Turtle* submarine.

Old Newgate Prison (East Granby) [\$10 Adult Tickets & \$5 Youth Tickets]

• Take a photo inside the guardhouse.

Webb-Deane-Stevens Museum (Wethersfield) [Borrow museum pass from the library]

• Take a photo inside one of the houses.

Putnam Memorial State Park (Redding) [Free]

• Winter 1778-1779 Encampment for Gen. Israel Putnam; Franklin CT Troops encamped here. Take a photo at the "Guardhouse".

Connecticut Old Statehouse (Hartford) [Borrow museum pass from library]

• First CT Governor to serve in building was a signer of the Declaration of Independence, Lafayette was made a citizen in the building. Take a photo inside the building.

Lebanon Green (Lebanon) [Free]

• Take a photo in front of the Trumbull House
