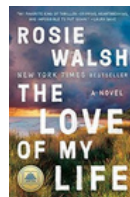

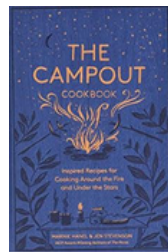

How Lucky Are You!? We will be having a special story hour and craft to celebrate St. Patrick's Day! Don't forget to wear green!

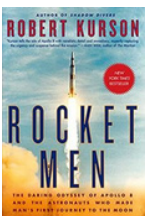

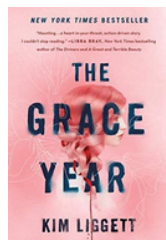
