(Starts at Giddings Park to Route 207 to Under the Mountain Road to Plains Road to Route 207 to Giddings Park)

8:45 AM - Laying of Wreaths and Prayer at War Memorials (Meetinghouse Hill Road)

9:00AM - Plains Cemetery Ceremony (Under the Mountain Road)

9:30 AM - Parade Line Up - Ayers Road (please see Jeff Glidden)

10:00 AM - Parade steps off from Ayers Road and continues to Pautipaug Cemetery

10:30 AM - Pautipaug Cemetery Ceremony (Route 207)

10:40 AM - Veteran's Park Memorial Ceremony (DPW Driveway)

11:00 AM - Pavilion Ceremony and light picnic (Giddings Park, Route 207)

12:15 PM - Softball Game at the little league field. Join either the FD team or the Rec Dept. team!
